LDWI Budget Adjustment for FY2007 is funding the following programs: PVTs, ASPEN detention Center, DWI Officer, Server for Sheriff's Office, IR8000 for Roswell Police

Department, Project Graduation, Digital cameras for State Police and Save a Life Tour. All this adds up to be \$80,000.00.

DFA requires the program to hire a Prevention Specialists. Before they weren't as strict but now it is required. We are currently working on the specs for this position.

Every 15 minute report has not been received. Heard it was a huge success.

DWI Gant funded law enforcement is still moving forward. Waiting on approval from DFA.

A motion was made to approve Saturation Patrol for Lake Arthur from May 21<sup>st</sup> thru May 31<sup>st</sup> by Bobby Sanchez and second by Chief Cass Mason. A total of 20 hours per officer will be allocated.

Open House @ NMDOT on May 9<sup>th</sup> had around 600 kids attended and gave out goodies to them pencils, rulers and coloring books. It was a huge success. We will probably attend next year.

LE DWI training will be on August 14, 15 & 16 in Santa Fe anyone interested in this training or any other training please let Mr. Halvorson know and he can arrange travel expenses.

On May 21<sup>st</sup> there will be a training offered in Las Cruces for Law Enforcement on Road Blocks. There is no charge for this training.
