Screener- Dianne Meda

Reported 10 DWI Screenings were completed. It has been a slow month a lot of people are getting sick.

JL Norris Counseling – Patricia Johnson

Reported eight (6) clients are in group and twenty (23) on individual counseling. And four were referred from the DWI program. Victim Impact Presentation had 23 participants for this month.

Teen Court- Jim Kisselburg

The program currently has 35-40 kids volunteering. Mr. Kisselburg applied for a Grant from Armstrong Clark for the amount of \$5,000. If awarded, this money will help with the food and refreshments for the volunteers. They had a Krispy Kreme fundraiser with a \$900.00 profit.

DWI Court Compliance

They currently have 420 active clients. And 73 clients are serving Community service.

Dexter, Hagerman and Lake Arthur Schools – Diane Taylor

Ms. Taylor is working to start a program with University High School.

Ms. Taylor updated council on Memorial Sign the criteria from the State if the person that was driving was under the influence he/she cannot be on the sign.

Law Enforcement – Sheriff –Rob Coon

Agency is currently waiting on new contract with ODWI to start working on checkpoints and saturation patrols.
