Screeener- Dianne Meda- Once a DWI offender is convicted that person is required to do a Screening. She screens from 20-25 per month. This involves some Domestic cases and Public defenders are asking for Presentence report. This year this contract will be self sufficient.

Teen Court- DWI Grant partially funds this program as well. Teens are going to Court and being sentenced by other offenders. All Teens are required to have their Parents with them.

Court Compliance- For the month of April Court Compliance has 297 active Probation Clients. There are 167 clients that are still pending and have not had a court date.
